### **2012-2013 PROGRAM RATE SHEET**

#### ***Primary Program 3-6 years***

Enrollment Minimum Age: 3 years

Children must be completely potty-trained to enroll.

#### **Half Day Program**

9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. (Includes lunch period).

3 day rate - \$455.00/month

5 day rate - \$620.00/month

#### **Full Day Program**

8:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. - \$ 705.00/month

9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. - \$ 705.00/month

Both classes are a 5-day program.

#### **Kindergarten Eligibility**

Sundance Montessori will not enroll children in the Kindergarten program, regardless of their abilities, if they are under 5 years old after the cut off date. \*

California Department of Education Kindergarten cut off is December 2 (Education Code Section 48000). Kindergarten students must attend school 5 days a week.

#### ***Elementary Program***

Enrollment Minimum Age: 6 years or completion of Kindergarten

Registration: \$465.00 new student                      \$410.00 Intel employee discount &                      \$165.00 returning student

#### **Enrollment Eligibility**

Students enrolling in the Elementary Program must be 6 at the start of the school year, or be a fourth-year student. (They have been enrolled in the Early Childhood Program for three years prior or completed Kindergarten from another school).

Elementary rate - \$ 715.00/month

#### **Parent Participation Requirements**

Full-time student = 25 hours/per year  
30 hours/per year for families with 2 or more children enrolled

Part-time student = 12 hours/per year

#### **Annual Supply Fee**

\$200.00 per student

#### **Morning Care**

Hours of care 7:30 a.m. – 8:45 a.m. Rate: \$3.00/hour. Invoiced quarterly.

**NON –DISCRIMINATION POLICY**

Students are admitted without regard to race, color, religion, nationality or ethnic origin.

**PARENT PARTICIPATION**

Families are expected to participate actively in the school community by contributing 12 hours of service for half day students, and 25 hours of service for full day students. 30 hours are expected from families with more than one child. There is an optional buy-out if parents are unable to participate.

**SIBLING DISCOUNT**

The 5% sibling discount is only applicable for one child in the 10 or 12 month installment plan.

**TUITION OBLIGATION**

Tuition is the amount paid for the whole academic year, 180 days, or the fraction of part-time program. You may elect to pay the full annual tuition on July 10<sup>th</sup>, or make two payments, due July 10<sup>th</sup> and December 10<sup>th</sup>, or on deferred terms in 10 installments paid July 10<sup>th</sup> – April 10<sup>th</sup> or 12 month installments paid July 10<sup>th</sup> – June 10<sup>th</sup>.

**FINANCIAL AID**

Financial aid is open to all families. Please see the Admissions Office to inquire more information on applying for financial aid.

**ABSENCES AND VACATION**

There are no credits issued for absences due to illness, vacations, personal leaves and other causes.

**LATE PAYMENT**

A late fee will be assessed at 10% of the monthly tuition not received on the agreed due date.

**DELINQUENT ACCOUNTS**

Any account over 60 days past due will forfeit the right of the child to attend class until all amounts past due are paid in full.

**WITHDRAWAL FROM SCHOOL**

You have the right to withdraw your child with a 30-day written notice (4 full weeks, excluding holidays and breaks). The notice of withdrawal must be made in writing. Once paid, tuition fees are non-refundable. If full tuition has been paid in advance, a refund of tuition will be issued for each full month remaining, and the advance payment discount will no longer apply.

The school office is closed during the month of August. Any changes in your child's enrollment status will not be accepted during the month of August. If you intend to withdraw before the start of the school year, the Admissions Office must receive your 30-day notice prior to July 29<sup>th</sup>.
